Superhero story

Today you are going to create a story including you as a superhero and your enemy. Talk to your adult about what your story. *What will the enemy do? How will the superhero solve the problem?*

Either use puppets/models to tell your story orally. Or, write a short story, taking it in turns with your adult to write if necessary. We'd love to see these uploaded to Tapestry so that we can enjoy your superhero adventures too!

Superhero challenge!

Superheroes need to be super fit and supple. They need to practise stretching and using their muscles. When superheroes are training, they get hot and sweaty so remember to cool down afterwards and drink lots of water too. Use the activity sheet to complete as many challenges as you can!

Maths

More or less?

Both you and your adult choose a number card. Count out the correct number of objects to match your numbers. *Who has more / less? How do you know?* Repeat for other numbers.

Layout 5 superhero toys/number cards in a line. Turn over the first card. Do you think the next number will be more (higher) or less (lower)? How far along the line can you get?

Both, you and your adult choose 2 superhero toys/ number cards. Use resources to add the two numbers together. Who has the highest /lowest total?

Phonics

It's bingo time! Today's bingo is going to be capital letter and lowercase letter matching. First draw your bingo grids, make them 3 x 3 squares.

Write down the uppercase alphabet on individual pieces of paper (feel free to choose a selection of 12 letters if you are short on time!) and place them into a box or bowl. Now all the players need to choose 9 lower case pre-cursive letters to write into their bingo grid.

Take it in turns to draw out capital letters from the box, and if it is the match for your lower case letter then you can cross it off your bingo grid. Your child may need some support to match up the letters
