Split the pile in 2 so that you both have 1 of every word and shuffle them. Now play snap – when you turn a matching word over you get to be the shark and (pretend to!) gobble the other person's hand 😊

– lobster – urchin - plankton

Mister Seahorse by Eric Carle

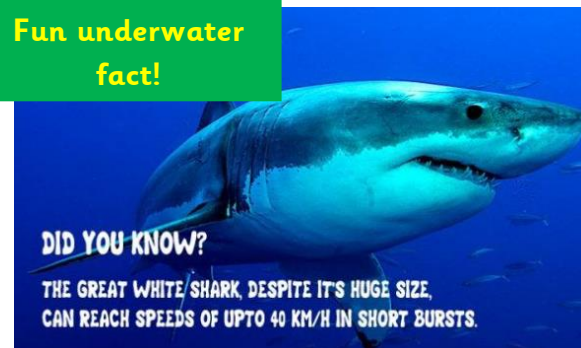
Barry the Fish with Fingers by Sue Hendra
