2. What evidence in the story tells us that Jack and his mum was poor?
3. How do you think Jack felt when he saw a beanstalk out of his window?
4. Why did Jack run into a cupboard when he heard 'Fee Fi fo fum'?
5. Use one word to describe Jack's actions in the castle.
6. How did Jack's mum feel once she saw the golden eggs and harp?

1. *Jack's mum was angry because she had sent Jack with their last valuable possession to get money and Jack returned with beans. Not money.*
2. *Jack and his mum were as we know they had one valuable possession and the story says that they are poor.*
3. *Jack was shocked, but curious. He wanted to know where the beanstalk led.*
4. *Jack ran into the cupboard for his safety, he was scared.*
5. *Brave*
6. *Jack's mum felt relieved when she saw the valuable items.*





Your mission today is to change the story of Jack and bean stalk.
Using the story above rewrite the story of Jack and the bean stalk. We are happy for you to dictate the story to an adult and they can write the story too.



