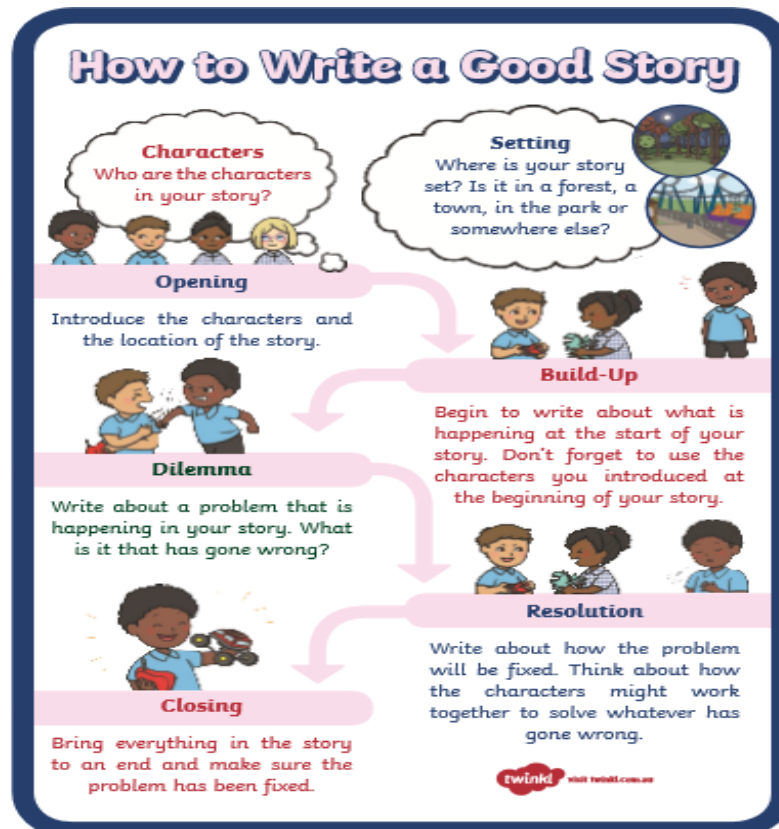
Your mission today is to plan and begin to write a short story. Your story will be unique because characters from different Traditional Tales will come together to create a brand new story!

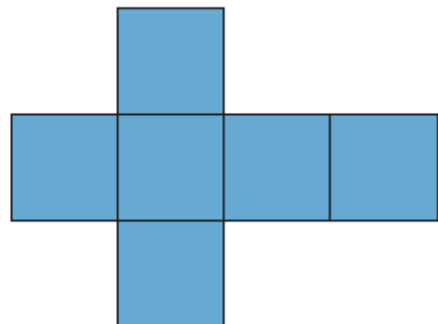
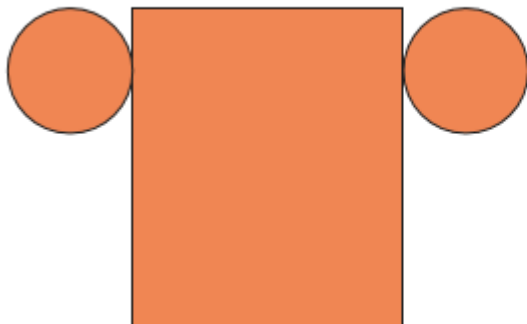
