Hi mum and dad!

First, I want you to know that Kelsie and I are safe. I am sure that you must have been going crazy with worry over the last few days. I'm sorry it has taken me this long to get a message to you. The phone lines are down or being clogged by thousands of people trying to do the same thing: reassure loved ones. I lost my mobile phone when it hit. This is the only way I could think to get in touch for the time being. The Internet is patchy here, so I'm hoping this will send.

It's so horrible here. I wish I could come home. The doctors and nurses are trying their hardest, but there are just too many injuries to deal with. It's only been two days since it happened. Hopefully, it will start to ease off over the next few days.

I'm sure you can imagine just how terrifying the whole thing was. We were on the beach about to have a morning swim when we felt the ground start to shake. The next thing we knew, everybody was screaming and running. We saw people trampling others to get past. We had no idea what was happening, but we knew it was serious. I don't know what would have happened if we'd been asleep or in the sea. Some people weren't so lucky.

I wasn't thinking of anything but saving us both from being crushed at that point. I told Kelsie to head for the field at the back of the hotel where there was more space. We didn't make it. The noise was horrific. I thought it was people screaming at first, but it was the sound of the tsunami crashing into the hotel behind us.

Something hit me on the head when the wave struck. I wasn't knocked out, just dazed. I remember seeing Kelsie holding desperately on to a palm tree as I was swept past. Everything I tried to grab

just slipped through my fingers. At that point, I felt sure I was going to drown.

I got lucky. Something hard hit me on my back and knocked the air from my lungs. I tried to see what it was, but the water was pressing me so hard against it that I couldn't turn. I could see Kelsie still, but she was too far to reach.

awake, busy, dangerous, deadly, lively, nocturnal, noisy, pitch-black, predator-filled

What Is the Emergent Layer Like?

bright, broad-leaved, hardwood, looming, noisy, rainy, sunlit, top-heavy, towering, unsteady, windy

What Sounds Can Be Heard?

buzzing, chattering, clicking, dripping, flapping, growling, howling, loud, rustling, scuttling, shrieking, splashing, squawking, stridulating, trickling, vocalising

What Is the Understorey Like?

damp, dangerous, food-rich, hot, humid, leafy, lively, low-light, moist, patchy, shaded, sheltered, speckled, sun-dappled, teeming, warm, wet

How Could You Describe a Rainforest?

abundant, biodiverse, chaotic, dense, essential, impassable, impenetrable, inaccessible, luxuriant, mysterious, primitive, pristine, remote, temperate, tough, undisturbed, unexplored, vast

How Could You Describe the Forest Floor?

dank, dark, decaying, decomposing, earthy, hot, infested, putrid, rotting, shaded, shadowy, unlit

ANSWERS

- 1) $\pounds 10.20 + \pounds 50.00 = \pounds 60.20$
 $\pounds 65 - \pounds 60.20$ (Use column method) = $\pounds 4.80$
- 2) $\pounds 1.24 + 23\text{p} + \pounds 1.60 = \pounds 3.07$
- 3) $\pounds 4.50 + \pounds 10.00 = \pounds 14.50$
 $\pounds 20.00 - \pounds 14.50 = \pounds 5.50$
- 4) $\pounds 125 + \pounds 2.35 = \pounds 127.35$
- 5) $23\text{p} \times 3 = 69\text{p}$
 $\pounds 1.24 \times 2 = \pounds 2.48$
 $\pounds 2.48 + 69\text{p} = \pounds 3.17$
How much change would you get from $\pounds 5$?
 $\pounds 5.00 - \pounds 3.17 = \pounds 1.83$
