

KS1 and KS2 Home Learning Timetable.

Dear Parents/Carers,

Please find below a timetable for online learning for years one-year five.

Microsoft TEAMS is the platform that online learning will be delivered on. **Daily online learning will commence for on Monday 11th January and will run until February Half Term**, unless changes are made by the UK government.

Please ensure that by the start of the ‘virtual academy day’, children are dressed appropriately. They also need to have had breakfast and be in a space appropriate for working. You might want to consider investing in a cheap pair of headphones if there will be a number of people working in a small space. Children will be required to put their cameras on and will be taught how to blur their backgrounds for safeguarding purposes.

	Time	Learning
Daily Monday-Friday	8:30-9:00	<p>Monday, Wednesday, Friday → PE with Sam. Sam will pre-record these sessions which your child can work through at their pace. Ensure your child has comfortable clothes and a place to work out. These can be found in the PE channel of the year group TEAM.</p> <p>Tuesday, Thursday → Go on either Timetable Rockstars (Y2 – Y5) or Reading Eggs (Reception – Y1 – further info to follow on how to get logged on and signed in). You may also wish to practice your times tables on Hit The Button or The Maths Factor.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>This is not a live lesson – your child does not need to log into TEAMS. This is self directed time and can be built in to any part of the day.</i></p>
	9:00-10:00	<p>Reading/Phonics: On TEAMS, go onto the ‘Reading/Phonics’ channel. Your child will have live lesson with a teacher from OAMR.</p> <p>Following the live lesson (which will last 15-30mins depending on your child’s age) your child will be left a task to complete. This may be to work on an app, complete a written response, complete a quiz or some extended reading/writing depending on their age.</p> <p style="background-color: yellow; text-align: center;">Your child will receive feedback on the assignment tab as appropriate.</p>
	10:00-11:00	<p>English: On TEAMS, go to the channel ‘English’. Your child will have live lesson with a teacher from OAMR.</p> <p>Following the live lesson (which will last 15-30mins depending on your child’s age) your child will be left a task to complete.</p> <p style="background-color: yellow; text-align: center;">Your child will receive feedback on the assignment tab as appropriate.</p>

	11:00-11:30	<p>BREAK TIME</p> <p>Your child could play with toys at home, relax, play a game, go outside, you could go for a walk, connect with friends or just have some down time. You might want to schedule in a drink or a snack, and maybe a toilet break. Children in school will be having their outdoor break time during this session.</p>
	11:30-12:30	<p>Maths: On TEAMS, go to the channel 'Maths'. Your child will have live lesson with a teacher from OAMR.</p> <p>Following the live lesson (which will last 15-30mins depending on your child's age) your child will be left a task to complete.</p> <p>Your child will receive feedback on the assignment tab as appropriate.</p>
	12:30-1:30	<p>LUNCH TIME</p>
	1:30-2:30	<p>Wider Curriculum Input: On Teams, go to the channel the channel for the afternoon subject being taught. This could be geography, history, science RE and may also be some aspects of Art and/or DT. Your teacher will communicate where to find this.</p> <p>Your child will have either a live or a pre-recorded wider curriculum lesson to work through at their own pace and then may be left a task to do once they have watched this lesson.</p>
	2:30 – 3:30	<p>Read Aloud/ Any daily Notices: On Teams, go to the 'Read Aloud' channel. Your child will be read a story, or a chapter or two of their class story book and notices or messages will be given out for the following day. This may be live or pre-recorded.</p>

If your child is unable to log into TEAMS at the set times for these sessions, they will be able to access the work set at any time via the TEAMS chat and files functions. If your child receives additional support in school, they will be contacted separately about additional opportunities to connect with support staff.

If your child's iPad cannot log onto TEAMS please contact servicedesk@oasisuk.org as soon as possible.
